

### Floor Plans Step-By-Step

Step 1: Jump in and start drawing!

>> The first thing you want to do is pick a drawing tool. You will probably want to pick the \*wall\* drawing tool first, but you can always pick from any drawing tool you want by pressing one of the square tool bar buttons.

Step 2: Glance at the help

>> Notice that when you choose a tool, the help screen changes. The help screen also provides links to tech support, or navigation to interesting links.

Step 3: Start Clicking!

>> Usually, you just want to start clicking on the drawing surface to draw your object. You will use both of your \*right\* and \*left\* mouse buttons.

Step 4: Select and Change

>> After you draw objects, you can \*select\* them with the \*pointer\* tool and then change the selected object by modifying the values in the appropriate tool bar boxes.

### Draw Wall Step-By-Step

Step 1: Click a point (to start drawing your wall).

>> If you pick a starting point \*near\* to another wall, or a starting point close to the \*end\* of another wall, you will create a wall join (either a join or a wall corner).

Step 2: Move your mouse.

>> Notice that the approximate length of the wall appears in the bottom status bar.

Step 3: Move your mouse until it is near another wall (to create a wall join).

>> When you are close enough, your wall will change color to either yellow or green. Green means that you will create a wall corner, instead of a simple wall join. windows-doors

Step 4: Click to finish/join.

### Draw Area/Region/Shape Step-By-Step

Step 1: Start clicking to make corners.

>> Just start clicking and moving your mouse in order to make the corners of your filled in area or shape.

Step 2: Right click when done.

>> Right click your mouse when you have drawn all teh corners of your drawing area and to stop adding corners to your filled area or shape.

### Windows and Doors Step-By-Step

Step 1: Pick a Window or Door Type.

>> Choose the type of window or door that you want to create by selecting one of the items from the drop down selection box.

Step 2: Click on a wall.

>> Pick a wall where you want to place your window or door.

Step 3: Position the window or door.

>> Move your mouse to position the door or window in the exact position you want.

Step 4: Click again to stop positioning.

Step 5: Change door orientation.

>> Go to the Edit menu, and select the Edit selected menu item. Choose change door orientation.
